## Almost Free Building Permit Month Begins in June!

It's time to head to the home improvement store and kick-off that summer project. Don't forget that during the month of June, the City of Dacono is offering "Almost Free Building Permits". In an effort to encourage residents of Dacono to upgrade and improve their residential properties, the City Council will temporarily reduce the amount of certain fees associated with issuing residential building permits during the entire month of June. This includes application fees, plan review and inspection fees. The fee reduction applies towards the alteration, repair or improvement of existing residential structures and the erection, alteration, repair or improvement of structures associated with existing homes, such as garages, additions, carports, sheds and fences. Payment of use tax still applies. All necessary permits must be obtained prior to beginning your project. As always, any work completed without a building permit is subject to double permit fees. Work authorized under the permit must be completed by no later than September 30, 2013, otherwise all applicable fees, including the full building permit fee and plan review fees and inspection fees, shall be paid. ## Outdoor Water Restriction In Effect Through September 30

Citing the dry winter and ongoing drought throughout the State of Colorado, the City of Dacono is enforcing mandatory water restrictions for all of its water customers effective April 1. Late spring and early summer snowmelt and runoff from the Rocky Mountains provides most of Colorado's water supply. Snowpack levels and reservoirs are very low after a dry winter. "The continuing drought conditions means everyone's cooperation is critical to making our water supply last and preventing the implementation of more restrictions in the future", said Mayor Charles Sigman. The City of Dacono does not sell treated water for oil and gas drilling purposes. The City last enacted mandatory water restrictions in 2007.

### Water Restrictions

- ◆ Residential customers (single-family homes, duplexes & townhomes) with **EVEN** number street addresses: **Sunday, Tuesday, & Friday** only be-

fore 10:00 a.m. and after 6:00 p.m. & shall not exceed four (4) hours total.

### Water restrictions should not be confused with ongoing water conservation efforts.

- ◆ Residential customers (single-family homes, duplexes, & townhomes) with **ODD** number street addresses: **Saturday, Monday, & Wednesday** only before 10:00 a.m. and after 6:00 p.m. & shall not exceed four (4) hours total.
- ◆ Non-residential customers (commercial properties), multi-family units, and Home Owner Associations (HOA)- may water on **Sunday, Tuesday & Friday** only before 10:00 a.m. & after 6:00 p.m.

- ◆ Landscaped areas (*lawns, gardens, parks, rights-of-way and medians*) may be watered by

a hand-held hose with a positive shutoff nozzle, drip irrigation system, faucet filled bucket or watering can of five (5) gallons or less **on any day, but not between the hours of 10 a.m. to 6 p.m. and may not exceed four (4) hours on any day.**

- ◆ Motor vehicles (*including motorbikes, boats, trailers, etc.*) can be washed **on any day, but not between the hours from 10 a.m. to 6 p.m. and only with a hand-held bucket or hose equipped with a positive shutoff nozzle** for quick rinses. Vehicle washing at a commercial car wash may be done at any time.

- ◆ Potable water shall be used for beneficial purposes and should not be wasted.
