June is Almost Free Building Permit Month!

It's time to head to the home improvement store and kick-off that summer project. Don't forget that during the month of June, the City of Dacono is offering "Almost Free Building Permits." In an effort to encourage residents of Dacono to upgrade and improve their residential properties, the City Council will temporarily reduce the amount of certain fees associated with issuing residential building permits during the entire month of June. This includes application fees, plan review, and inspection fees. The fee reduction applies towards the alteration, repair, or improvement of existing residential structures and the erection, alteration, repair or improvement of structures associated with existing homes, such as garages, additions, carports, sheds and fences. Payment of use tax still applies. All necessary permits must be obtained prior to beginning your project. As always, any work completed without a building permit is subject to double permit fees. Work authorized under the permit must be completed by no later than September 30, 2016, otherwise all applicable fees, including the full building permit fee and plan review fees and inspection fees, shall be paid. 
